POLITICAL SESSIONS

To allow sufficient time for you to transit through security, be signed in and escorted into the Parliamentary Wing we suggest you arrive at Parliament House at **9.00am** as the Briefings will now commence at 9.30am.

We would like to mention that it may be prudent to fly in the night before to avoid any inclement weather conditions (incl fog). If you are flying into Canberra on 11 September from any of the eastern States, then the 6.30am services should get you to Canberra in plenty of time.
